

The Department of Cognitive and Learning Sciences at Michigan Technological University seeks applicants for 2 tenure-track positions in Psychology, one Assistant Professor and one Assistant or Associate Professor to begin Fall 2010. The positions are part of our newly approved Ph.D. program in Applied Cognitive Science and Human Factors. All areas of specialization considered, but candidates with backgrounds in human factors, experimental psychology, applied cognitive science, and quantitative methods/advanced statistics are of particular interest. A Ph.D. in psychology or a related discipline required by August 2010.

Current program strengths are in human factors, experimental, cognitive, and forensic psychology. The ideal candidate will be interested in expanding upon existing research collaborations with faculty in engineering and computer science (human factors, cognitive engineering, HCI), biology (neuroergonomics, physiological psychology), and/or exercise science (kinesiology, ergonomics). Candidates' research programs should have strong potential to attract external funding. Typical teaching load is 2 courses per semester, consisting of a combination of graduate and undergraduate courses.

Michigan Tech, with 22 Ph.D. programs and 34 master's degree programs, is a public mid-sized institution classified as a Research University with high research activity (RU/H). Michigan Tech is ranked in the top tier of national universities according to the *U.S. News & World Report's* "America's Best Colleges 2009" and is ranked a "tech powerhouse" by *Princeton Review's* "Best 361 Colleges."
